
'Pizza and Praise' from St John's Higham join us for this session. A time of family worship, praise, food and fun! All youngsters welcome, accompanied by a parent.

**Carol Service - 6pm – Sunday 21st December –** traditional service of readings and music. All welcome. Mulled wine and mince pies served in The Refectory following the service.




## Christingle service - 6pm Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> December - Christmas Eve
