All Lord, I am not worthy to receive you,

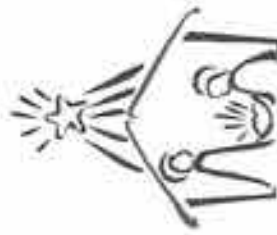
but only say the word, and I shall be made whole.
