In recent weeks, as I walk to Curzon and around the streets of Allestree, I have noticed the tiny coloured top of a crocus pushing through the cold ground. It is perfectly normal and a well-known characteristic for crocuses to appear and bloom in the winter, sometimes even through frost or snow.



These small and resilient flowers are beautifully adapted to thrive in cold conditions. They remind us that life can begin to emerge long before the warmth of spring arrives. In the same way, we are beginning to see the first signs of what God is doing across the churches in Allestree. May we not lose heart or resilience as these first signs appear. Let us be filled with joy and continue to work hand-in-hand with God and all He is doing. May we be people in 2026 who offer spiritual water, sunlight and good ground, trusting that God will ultimately bring the grow in all these exciting new things in the year ahead.

Across our churches, we continue to hear stories of people walking through our doors simply because they felt prompted to come to return to church and to God. We truly believe God is moving in this generation, drawing people back to Him in ways only He can, so may we have welcoming hearts to all those who come.
