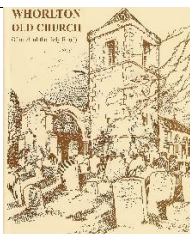

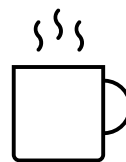

Reports



We were able to send a total of £659 to CRISIS this year after the Christmas celebrations, partly raised at the **Village Lunch** and also at the **Carol Singing**. Both occasions were most successful.

Congratulations to the Village Lunch team and to Howard Rogers, the carver of the turkey, for a delicious meal. Once again the **Ripon City Band** led a large congregation in Church - even more people this year – and we made much music. A wonderful service followed by a visit to the Black Horse pub, thanks go to them for their hospitality.

The large **Christmas Tree** was bought from Mr Neil Metcalfe once again this year and put up by Mike Foster and Terry Andrews, assisted by Lorna, and taken down again too. It is a hard job, and we thank them most sincerely. The Potto Christmas Tree was given by Prestons of Potto, as usual, and we are most grateful.

Friday January 2nd saw village residents, in large groups, making their way to Holy Cross Church for the untimely funeral of **Glenn Shimwell**. There was an air of quiet solemnity across the village and both the church and church hall building were packed with mourners. Glenn was a generous and likeable man and villagers showed their fondness for him and their appreciation. Holy Cross church members were very pleased to be able to accommodate such a large number of mourners, around 600.

Following the very sad death of Glenn - a true supporter of our parish church - the church council is now looking for his replacement as keeper of the lawns around Holy Cross Church. Glenn volunteered to do this work a few years ago, and his dedication and competence in this role has always impressed everyone.

Keeping the lawns tidy around the village church and church hall and the grass outside the stone wall on Church Lane, is a seasonal activity, but also takes into account impending weddings and funerals. It does not involve the church yard at the Old Church at Whorlton. We do hope that someone will feel able to come forward and talk to us about the role.
