Message from Gill and Paul Thompson, Letcombe Bassett

By the end of the month I expect that our churchyards will be showing signs of life as crocuses and snowdrops peep above the ground, bringing colour to the early part of spring time.

The month of February in the church year is marked by an ending. On the first weekend of the month we celebrate the presentation of Christ in the Temple. This marks the end of the formal season of Christmas, a final example of the recognition of Christ as hope of the world, by Simeon and Anna.

After this event Jesus returned home with his parents and his growth was hidden from public view. But this hope is something that we can carry with us all the time, even in the dark times of the year when nothing seems to be growing. February 18th is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent, a season where we recognise the things in our lives that need to change, and try to clear them out of the way. Once the ground is clear, just as snowdrops and crocuses sprout from the winter ground, so we can start to show the world the light and hope hidden in our hearts.

Interregnum report from Paul Thompson

There isn't much new information for this month. We are continuing to work on collating the Benefice profile: a copy was sent out for review by churchwardens and representatives before Christmas.

We have also asked for up to date pictures of activities in our churches. Resources for Lent


To help us enter more fully into Lent the Church of England and the Diocese of Oxford have their own programmes of daily reflections and readings delivered to our phones.
