

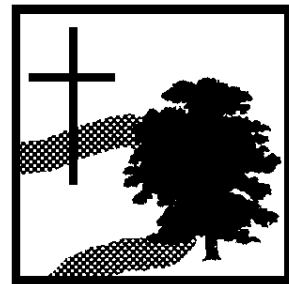

As I *write* this letter, we have just celebrated the Feast of the Epiphany (January 6th) when the Wise Men arrived to bring gifts to the infant Jesus. This is often the time when households take down their Christmas decorations.

As you *read* this letter at the beginning of February, we will be celebrating the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple on February 2nd, 40 days after Christmas. This event marks the end of the story cycle of the Nativity and early childhood of Jesus.

When Mary and Joseph went to the temple in Jerusalem to present Jesus they encountered two religious individuals, Simeon and Anna, who immediately recognised the infant Jesus as the promised Messiah. Simeon's prophecy, found in Luke's gospel (Luke 2:25-35) led to the feast being known as Candlemas, where candles are often blessed and carried in procession to symbolise Christ as the Light of the World.



So, whilst our Christmas decorations may come down in early January, the traditional Christian church season encompasses this entire period, concluding with the Temple presentation that formally bridges the Nativity stories with the rest of Jesus' life and ministry.

ASH WEDNESDAY
First Day of Lent



Simeon's final words of prophecy move our attention away from the celebration of Christmas and towards the mysteries of Easter. 40 days before Easter we come to Ash Wednesday, this year being 18th February. This day marks the start of Lent and our preparations for our Easter celebrations. Morning Prayer will be held at 10am at Bramfield to mark this day.

In our society today, there is often a debate about whether to "give up" something for Lent, such as chocolates or alcohol or in more recent times, whether to "take up" something for Lent such as reading a Lent book or following a Lent App, making time for prayer or reflection each day or just taking time to review how we live our lives.

Whatever your preference, I'd like to encourage us all to take time during Lent to think and reflect about how we use the gifts that God has given to each one of us to serve God and our neighbours. God calls each of us to work together for the good of the world in which we live. By working together, we can make a difference in our communities whilst making the love of God known to those we meet. As Theodore Roosevelt is quoted as saying "People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care". A good thought indeed for our Lent reflection of our calling to serve God.

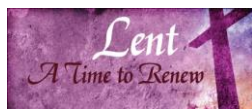

Waterford Nature Notes



While I was driving along Anchor Lane from Wadesmill to Tonwell, I spotted three Egyptian Geese grazing in a field. I can't remember when I last saw this species around here, my Southgate correspondent often reports to me upon these in his local parks and has been doing so for many years. The Southgate geese breed freely upon the lakes in two parks, usually raising broods of five but, on occasions seven or even up to nine. It seems that the geese have learned to recognize my correspondent and his wife because, although they have never fed them other than by casting appropriate food onto the water, the geese and their goslings, upon sighting them, will leave the water and come to them looking for food. It is only in recent years that Egyptian Goose has been included in books as a British Bird.

There have been reports of large Siskin flocks around the county, as many as 100 on occasions. As I have reported before, this species, along with several others, was a summer visitor until fairly recent years but gradually has become a resident, staying through Winter.



I read about efforts that have been made between St Albans City Council, Herts. and Middlesex Wildlife Trust (HMWT) and Butterfly Conservation to create areas that support butterflies. Surveys of the areas between 2022 and 2025 showed a 350% increase in numbers and, in the year 2025, the increase has been 80% upon 2024 numbers. What wonderful news. HMWT has done and continues to do wonders for nature in our counties, they have now topped 24,000 members. If you have any interest in nature, conservation and climate and are considering contributing, please think about joining, 50% off first year membership if you join in January:

Yet another example of changing seasons, the traditional time for Hazel catkins is late Winter to early Spring, i.e. end of February to end of March, I saw full-grown catkins more than a week before Christmas.

There have been some reports of suspected bird flu around Hertfordshire and nearby counties. It is water birds that are most likely to suffer. It would be wise to take precautions, even if there have not been any reports locally. Do not enter water or allow your pet to do so, don't handle or allow your pet to pick up any dead bird. Whenever refilling your bird-feeders use a disinfectant to wash out any pathogens that might have been imported, proprietary brands are available but a weak solution of bleach, about 8 or 10 - 1 followed by thorough rinsing will be just as effective.



On Christmas morning I was up at around 6a.m. to let the dogs into the garden, I heard many owls calling. There was a Tawny in the churchyard, another somewhere across the marsh, two more in the Sycamore wood of John Oakins, another in the plantation above 10 Timber Orchard and a Little Owl somewhere in the trees behind 3 and 4 Timber Orchard. The owl that had been calling in the churchyard flew across to the plantation above Timber Orchard and was silhouetted against the dawn, twilight sky. How wonderful that there is such a strong population. Barn and Short-eared have also been reported locally meaning that the only British species not seen are Long-eared and Snowy but the Snowy is a rare, Winter visitor to the very North of Britain, such as the Shetlands.

We all have questions we have wanted to ask,
about life, faith...what's going on...
but there's never been the right time or place...
