LENT - As we journey through Lent, we are invited to deepen our faith through prayer and Bible study and to show Christ's love by giving generously to those in need.

Pilgrimage Leaflets and Prayer Cards – We have ordered some prayer cards and leaflets which lead you round different points in the church on a mini-pilgrimage. These will be available from the back of church from the beginning of Lent. Please feel free to take any you want for yourself or to pass on.

We continue to collect for the **Foodbank** - donations can be left in the box at the back of church and go to help the homeless and those in need in Boston. Thank you for your ongoing support.

Our Lent Bible Study course will run on 5 Mondays starting on Monday 23rd February. This continues the Lincoln Diocese's course "Set our Hearts on Fire" which we started during Advent by looking at some of the ways in which we are called to be a community on fire with love for God. During five weeks of Lent, our attention turns inward, as we ask what aspects of our individual lives of Christian faith and discipleship might need a touch of 'holy fire'. All are very welcome to join us - each session is stand-alone so don't worry if you didn't get to the Advent Course or you can't make all the evenings.

The Lent Course 2026 themes:

- These things I pray – Hearts on fire, day by day
- Teach me, my God and King – Hearts on fire for learning
- Let me be as Christ to you – Hearts on fire for others
- All things come from you – Hearts on fire with generosity
- In fear and trembling – Hearts on fire with wonder



For those who wish to follow their own Bible study and reflections during Lent, the Church of England's theme this year is 'Draw Near: Life-giving habits for Lent'."
