LENT – A TIME TO REFLECT AND PREPARE

ASH WEDNESDAY a service of Holy Communion at 11.30am at St Bridget's including an invitation to be marked in ash with the sign of the cross. Please make a special effort to begin the season of Lent by coming along.

THURSDAYS IN LENT an early morning half hour service of Holy Communion at 7.30am.

LENT CALL A chance to talk to someone about the Bible reading used in church that week. No previous knowledge needed – it's simply a short phone call or facetime chat or coffee. A chance to talk about what puzzled you or particularly spoke to you. If you're interested let Paula know.

LENT BIBLE REFLECTION at the home of Joy Alcock, Tuesdays at 2pm – contact Joy on 625 8675 for more information. The theme will be the Gospel reading from the previous Sunday.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS a 30 minute service each Friday during Lent at 12 noon in the Lady Chapel at St Bridget's. We will reflect on two stations each week, allowing time for prayerful meditation as we journey together toward Easter. All are warmly welcome to pause, pray, and walk the way of the cross with us during this sacred season.

SOMETHING MORE? A small group discussion to explore questions of faith: If you are someone who has questions but worry you should already have the answers then this could be the group for

you. Whether you've been a Christian for 10 years or more, or just 10 minutes, you will be very welcome. There are just 2 sessions and they will last for 90 minutes with refreshments!

Session 1: Sunday 22nd February 4.30pm in the Centre and **repeated** on Thursday 26th February 10am at the Rectory and will consider what we understand or think about God.

Session 2: Thursday 26th March 10am at the Rectory and **repeated** on Sunday 29th March 4.30pm in the Centre and will be what we understand or think about Jesus. Please let Paula in the office or the Rector know if you would like to come.
