

KIRTON PARISH PRAYER CYCLE

Introduction

Each day we pray:

- For the growth of Christ's Church at Kirton
- For the streets of our community
- For the organisations that serve our parish

Ideas for how to pray using the prayer cycle

Begin by becoming still and recollected. You may wish to light a candle, hold a small cross or have one in front of you.

Make the sign of the Cross:

“In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
Amen.”

“God of mission,
Who alone brings growth to your Church,
Send your Holy Spirit to give Vision to our planning,
Wisdom to our actions,
Joy to our worship,
And power to our witness.

Help our church to grow in numbers,
In spiritual commitment to you,
And in service to our local community,
Through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Amen.”

Bring before God the **streets and organisation** appointed for the day. You could use the words:

“Lord God,
we commend to you the people of these

streets: [**Name the streets**]
and all who dwell and labour there.

We pray also for [**Name the organisation**],
and for all who serve or are supported by it.

Bless them with your peace,
protect them in their needs,
and draw them ever more deeply
into the knowledge of your love.

Grow your Church among us,
for the glory of your holy Name;
through Christ our Lord.
Amen.”
