## 100 Club Rules and Application Form

Hethe PCC raises funds every year for the running of St Edmund & St George Church. By joining the 100 Club you can help with this and work towards improving facilities as well as having a chance to win cash prizes every month!

St Edmund & St George Church 100 Club is run as a club and is open to all residents from the parish of Hethe and the surrounding area, their family and friends. Numbers, which are not transferable, will cost £2.00 a month (£24.00 annually). You must be 16 or over to join.

Each month from 14<sup>th</sup> January 2019 there will be a draw for 50% of the income. This amount shall be divided between 3 lucky winners. For example, if we have 100 members the income for that month will be £200 and 50% will be used as the prize fund i.e. £100 split into three prizes

- The 1st prize will be £50 (if 100 members)
- The 2nd prize will be £30 (if 100 members)
- The 3rd prize will be £20 (if 100 members)

The more people who buy a subscription - the higher the prize money!

You may have more than one number per month.

We would prefer for you to pay by Standing Order, but payment by cash or cheque will be accepted.

## St Edmund & St George - 100 Club Rules

1. The object of the Club is to raise funds for running costs and maintenance of the fabric of St Edmund & St George Church, Hethe.
2. The Club will be run under the supervision of Hethe PCC who will also administer the Club.
3. The club is open to all Residents of the Parish of Hethe and the surrounding area, their family and friends,
4. Members must be 16 or over.
5. Members must fill in an application form.
6. Entry to monthly draws will be by subscription of £2.00 per month (£24.00 annually) per number, paid in advance. Preferably by Standing Order.
7. Members may have more than one number. The 100 Club shall not be limited to 100 members.
8. Subsequent to the first draw in January 2019 additional new members will be entered for the draw in the calendar month that follows receipt of the first monthly payment. Responsibility for ensuring that the subscription has been paid rests with the individual member, not Hethe PCC.
9. The draw will be monthly - generally at Coffee Mornings held on the second Monday of each month.
10. Winners will be contacted personally by 100 Club administrators who will make all reasonable efforts to pay or post prizes to the winners within a week of each monthly draw.
11. Names of winners will be posted on St Edmund & St George Church notice board, in the Shelswell News and on the Hethe Parish Council website each month after the draw.
12. The regular monthly prize fund will be 50% of the monthly income - there will be three prizes:-
  - 1st prize = 50% of monthly prize fund (£50 if 100 members)
  - 2nd prize = 30% of monthly prize fund (£30 if 100 members)
  - 3rd prize = 20% of monthly prize fund (£20 if 100 members)
  - The remaining 50% of the fund will be allocated to St Edmund & St George expenses.
13. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into St Edmund & St George PCC Funds after 6 months.
16. The decision of Hethe PCC shall be final in all matters requiring adjudication.
17. Hethe PCC shall have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
