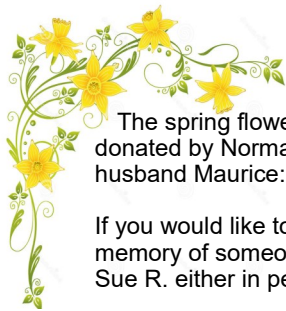

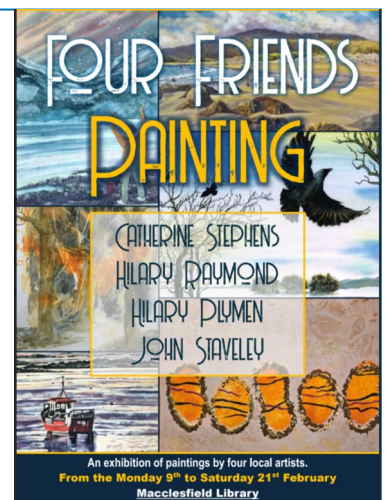
Martin will be writing to those he feels should definitely attend, but if you want to take part too then have a word with him ... and reserve the date: daytime, Saturday 7th March.

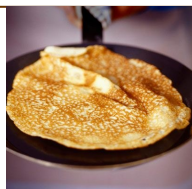

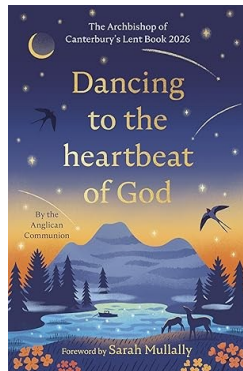

'Dancing to the Heartbeat of God' - the Lent study book recommended by our new Archbishop of Canterbury, Sarah Mullally.

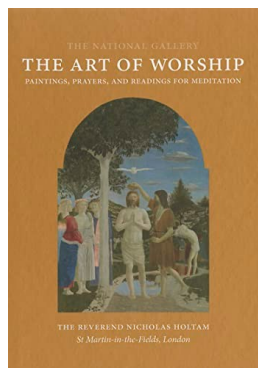
Groups which will be using this book meet at the following times:

Ash Wednesday Services

18th February

Please note that there will be two special services on **Ash Wednesday, 18th February** - one at **10.30am** and one at **6.30pm**.



These will involve the marking with ash (optional) as a sign of repentance, and will signal the start of Lent.

The services will be held in the Savage Chapel.

The evening service will last around 45 minutes. The morning service, which will also include Holy Communion, will last slightly longer.

Maundy Thursday

2nd April

Agape Meal with (optional) washing of feet



We will be holding a Maundy Thursday evening service, as we did last year, to reflect on the events of the night before Jesus' crucifixion, when He gave His disciples a 'new commandment' to love another. He illustrated this by Himself washing their feet; then He shared a meal with them: the basis for our Communion Service.

This Agape Service is one of quiet reflection, with liturgy, music, silence and symbolism, lasting approximately one hour.

This service will take place at **7.00pm on Maundy Thursday evening (2nd April)**.

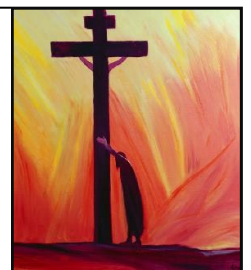
In order to cater appropriately (a simple 'meal') please speak to Lynne, Heike or Barbara to signal your intention to come along.
