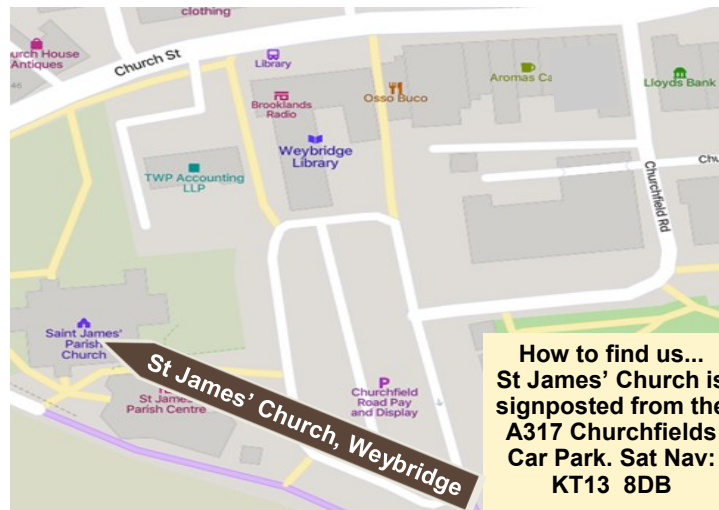

St James' Church - Living History

It is not known exactly how old the original church was, but it was believed to have been built sometime between 666 and 1175 meaning there may well have been a place of worship at the heart of Weybridge at the time of the Norman Conquest, with worship connected to Chertsey Abbey until the Reformation. Indeed Weybridge was a settlement recorded in the Domesday Book, in the hundred of Elmbridge and the county of Surrey. In 1848 the church was rebuilt in gothic style (one of the earliest works of John Loughborough Pearson). Once complete, the original much smaller medieval church building was demolished. St James' spire has lent us the nickname "Cathedral of the Thames Valley". Today we have the challenge of maintaining this 2* beautiful landmark building for the benefit of this community of Weybridge & future generations. Projects for 2026 include Tower spire re-pointing and creation of a new churchyard Garden of Remembrance for the burial of ashes.

St James' Church is open daily from 9.15am to 12.30pm when you are very welcome to take a tour, or just stop, rest, pray and perhaps light a candle or leave a prayer card. Everyone is always welcome at St James' Church.

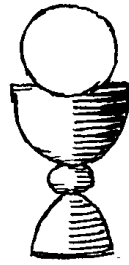
ST JAMES' CHURCH CHOIR
