Summer is here!

It's a great time of year! So many happy things going on, with summer outings, exams (nearly) over, and holidays ahead. It's the same in our villages too, especially with the ever-popular summer fêtes – great occasions for communities to come together, and for us all to be reminded that there's more to life than endless conflict and war; and that our relationships, our neighbourliness, and our love are what really makes the world go round. In church we often refer to the summer months as 'Ordinary Time' – a bit odd, really, as usually we wouldn't admit to things being 'ordinary'. We prefer to make out that everything is 'exciting', 'amazing' or 'awesome'. You hear such words in many churches – which is great, because the Christian message of hope, love and redemption is all of these things.

The truth, though, is that it's often in the ordinary times, when there's less going on, that we can see a bigger picture. This can be when real growth takes place, when we're freer to focus on the simple things. In our churches, that will mean deepening our prayer life, our relationships with God and with each other, and practising some good habits (including rest and recreation!). And such activities have their parallels in our wider community life too.

There will be one extraordinary event this month, when our Curate, Hannah Morris, is ordained priest at Norwich Cathedral, on Saturday 27th June. From this point on, she'll exercise the same duties as the other members of the clergy team – for example, taking weddings and baptisms, and presiding at Communion services. The day after her ordination, all our churches will come together for a service of Holy Communion which Hannah herself will lead for the very first time.

Everyone's welcome to attend this special service, and also to come to the bring-and-share lunch afterwards.

So, summer will continue on its way during 'Ordinary Time' – ordinary, not because it's dull, but rather because it's uncluttered – perfect, in other words, for strengthening the life we share together and with God too.
