

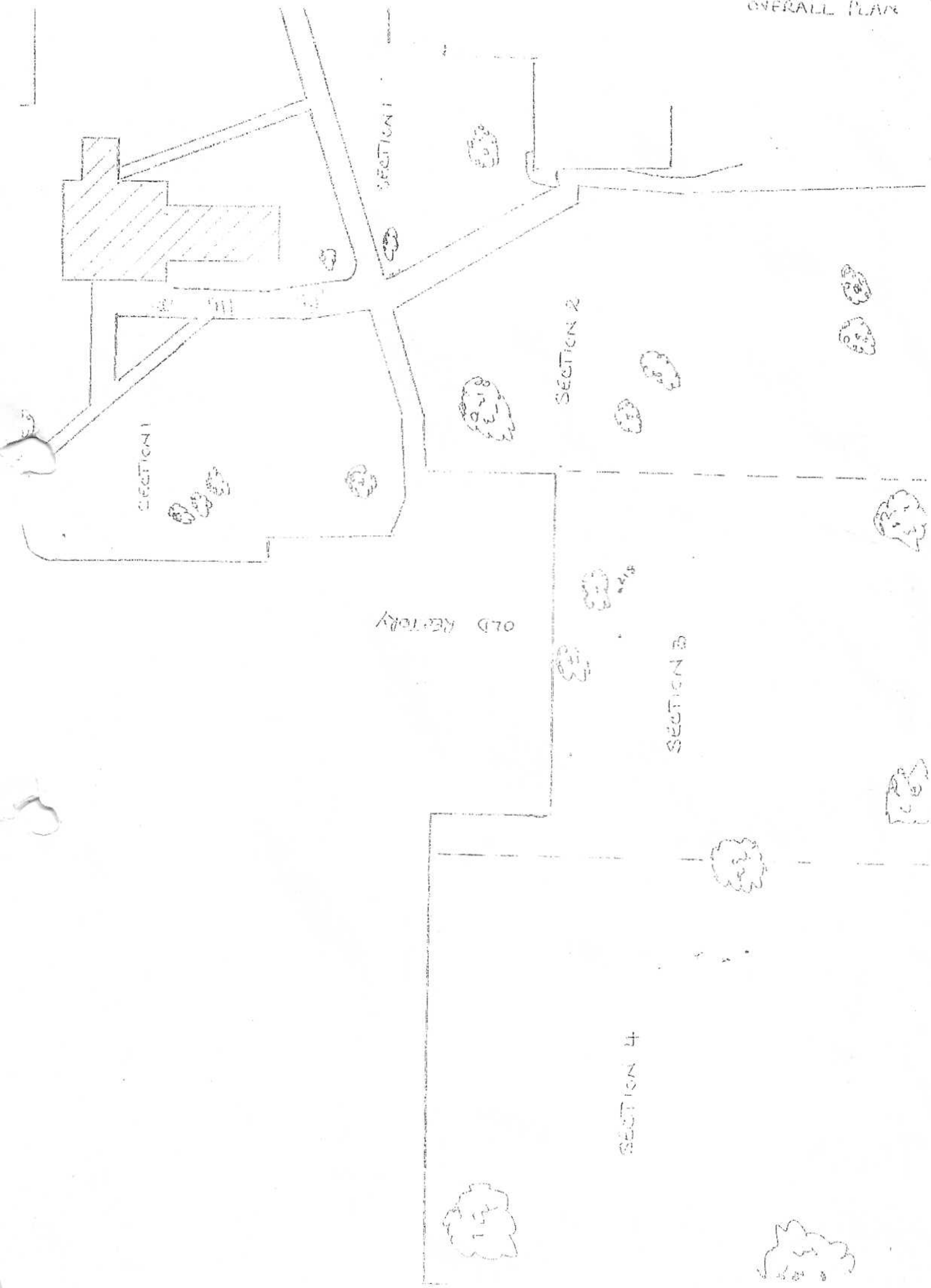

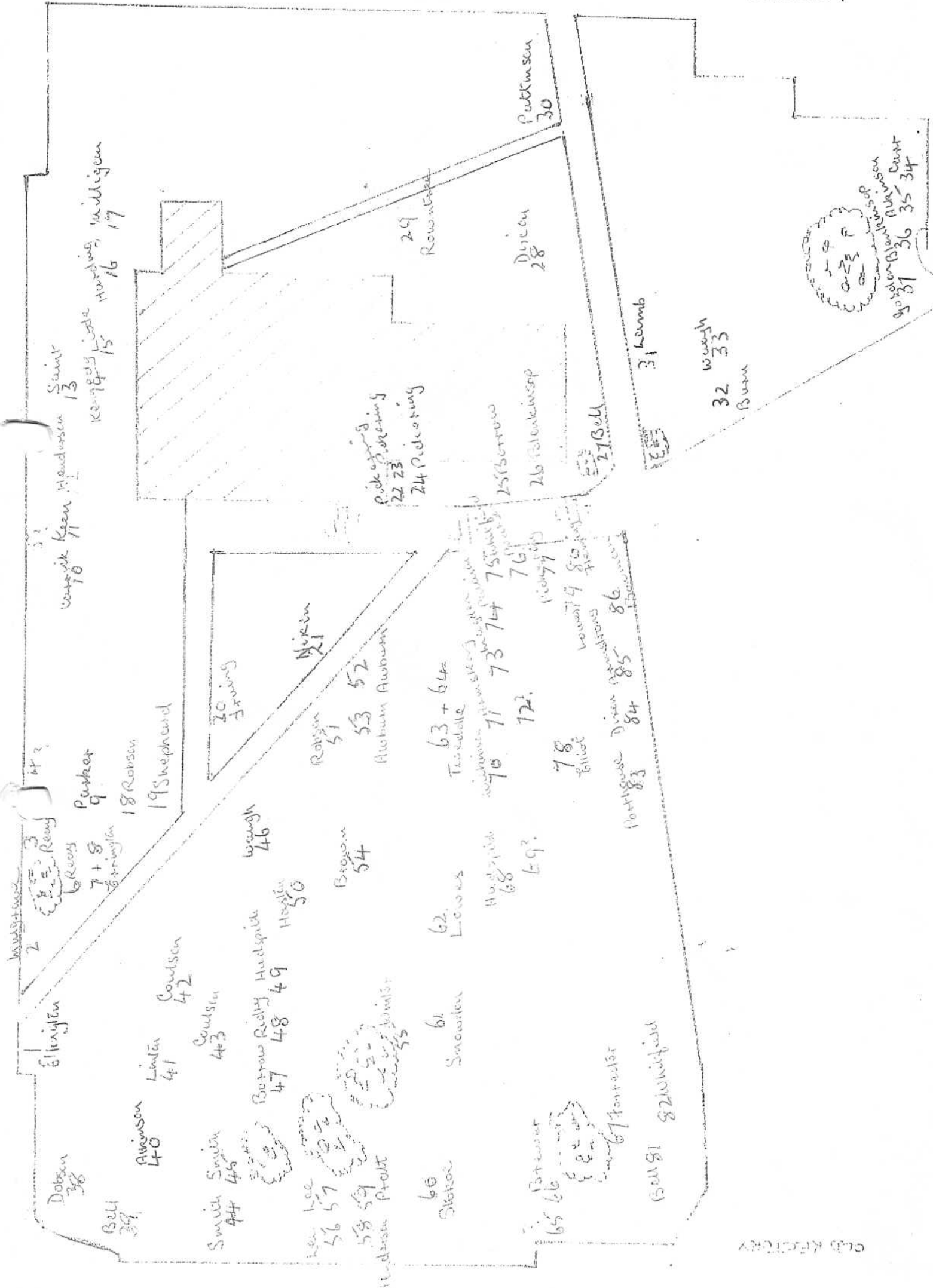
Schedule of tombstones in the

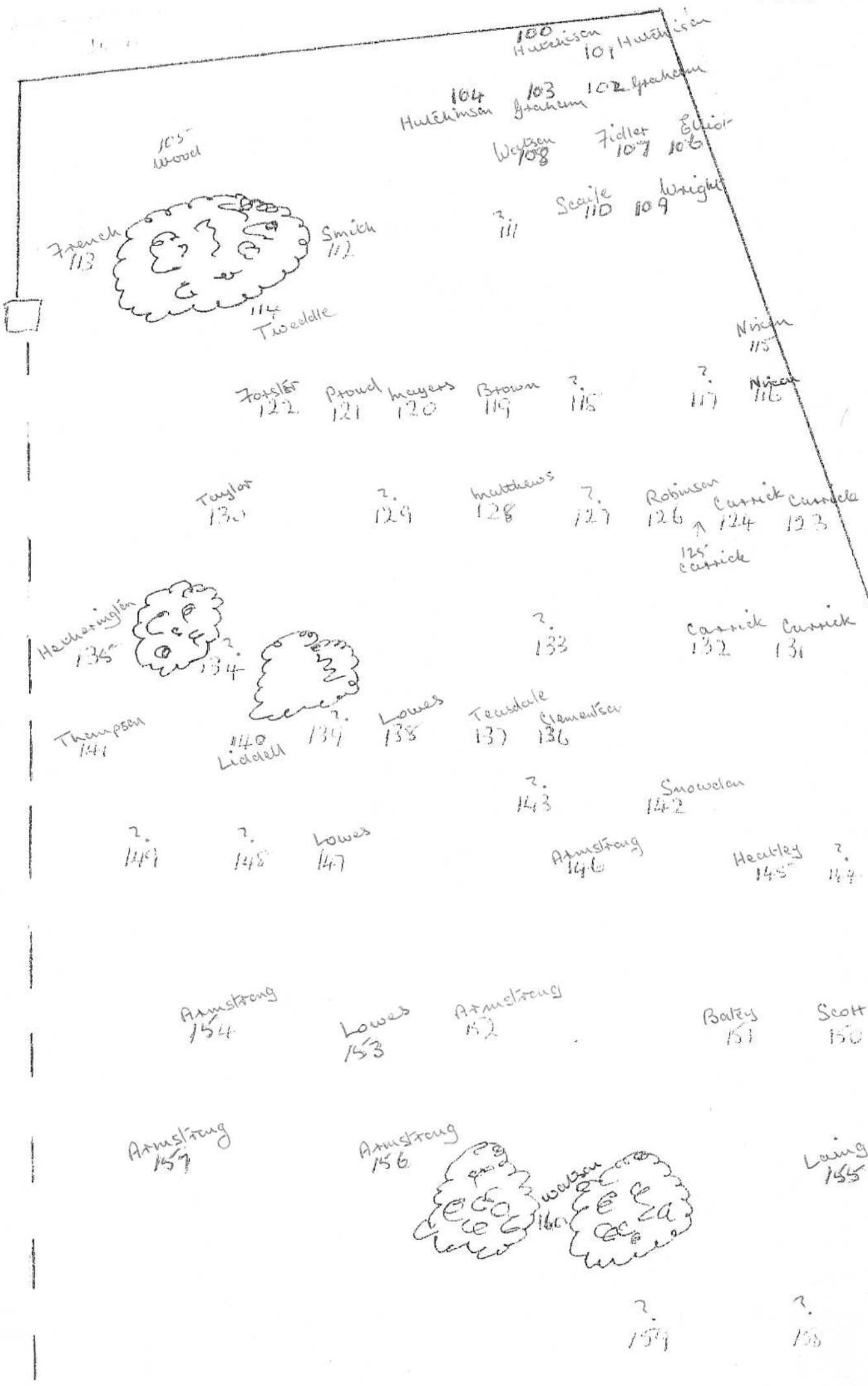

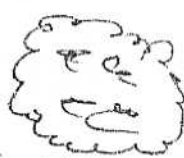

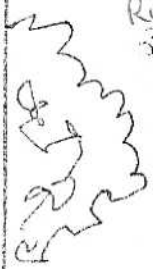
