'Pilgrimage and Journey' by Revd Hannah

Summer has always been a season for journeys. For centuries, Christians have marked the longer days not just with rest, but with pilgrimage. Stepping out of the familiar, travelling towards something holy, and often finding that the journey itself is where God meets us.

This July, I am joining a diocesan group led by Bishop Graham on pilgrimage to Taizé, a small village in Burgundy, France. Since the 1940s, Taizé has been home to an ecumenical monastic community whose simple, contemplative way of life has drawn hundreds of thousands of visitors, particularly young people, from across the world. At its heart are three times of prayer each day, built around short, repetitive chants that are easy to learn and deeply meditative. There are no sermons during the services, just stillness, song, and the quiet presence of God. And rather wonderfully, every pilgrim who visits is given a practical role in keeping the community running, whether that is washing up, cleaning, or helping to prepare meals. Pilgrimage, it turns out, is not a spectator sport. Many who visit Taizé describe it as genuinely transformative. I go as someone still finding my feet in ministry, and I suspect that is exactly the right frame of mind in which to make a pilgrimage. But I am also aware that pilgrimage is not only for those who travel. There is a sense in which this whole past year has been a pilgrimage.

You have walked alongside me through my first year of diaconal ministry, and my ordination to the priesthood. You have been generous with your encouragement, your patience, and your prayers, and I am more grateful than I can easily say.

So as the summer unfolds, whether you are journeying somewhere new or staying close to home, I hope you find moments of stillness and encounter. God has a habit of meeting us on the road.
