Both Church Councils are meeting this month, if there is anything you would like to raise please speak to Rev'd Rich or a PCC member.

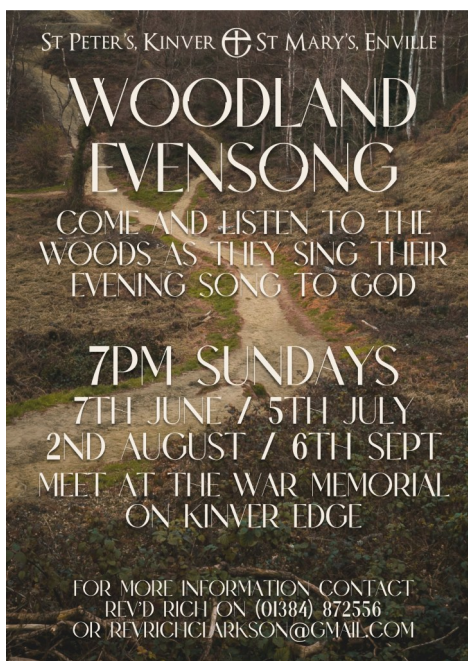
