Ralph Allwood, MBE was for 26 years Director of Music at Eton College and is now a freelance choral director, composer, teacher and conductor. He is the Director of the Rodolfus (ex-Eton) Choral Courses, which he founded in 1980. He is co-founder and conductor of Inner Voices, made up of singers from state schools in London. He is also a supervisor for harmony in Cambridge, Director of the only conservatoire chapel choir in the world, the Old Royal Naval College Trinity Laban Chapel Choir and an Honorary Fellow of University College, Durham. He is Chair of the Choral Evensong Trust and Patron of the Choir of the Earth.
