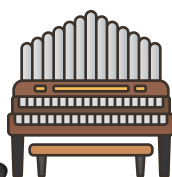
## Kirk Langley WI Meeting

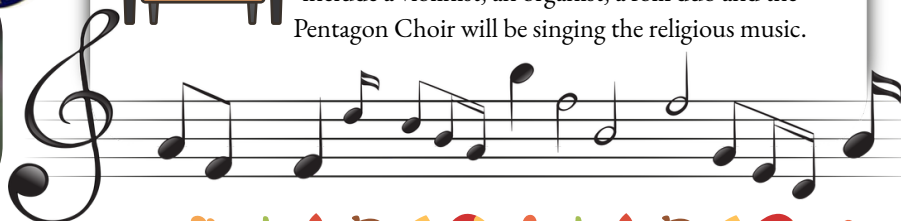


## 'A Celebration in Music'
