Installation of three EE Commscope RRZZVV-65B-R6N43 and three AIR 3268 antennas on bespoke steelwork behind the louvres

Installation of three 4419 ERS and three 4490 ERS and three Mk2 BOB fixed to CHS poles behind antennas.

Removal of the existing louvres and their replacement with replica GRP louvres

Internal upgrading of existing MBNL equipment room. Removal of existing EE BTS3900A cabinet on steel grillage and its replacement with S-AIRO cabinet on existing plinth
