## Sunday Worship

### 11am: The Parish Eucharist

Lasting about an hour. Our main gathering, Hymns, a Sermon and Holy Communion. Worship for all.

### Also, on the First Sunday of each Month:

### 8am: Holy Communion

Lasting about 30 minutes, a reflective, quiet Service, using traditional language.

### 6pm Evensong

Lasting about 40 minutes, Prayers and Readings.

### Every Wednesday:

9.30am: Holy Communion according to the Book of Common Prayer.

Our heritage Service, sharing in the deep well-springs of the Christian Tradition.

Our Monthly **Coffee Morning**, with Bring and Buy Stall, takes place on the **1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of every month**, from 10am to 12noon, in the Community Room, as you enter the Building.

**Level Access** is available to the Church building, and there are Kitchen Facilities and a Toilet.

**An Open Door:** The Church is usually open for 30 minutes or so before and after Services, and also on Friday Mornings, from April to September, from 11am to 1pm. An opportunity to call in, have a moment or two in peace, and **Light a Candle**.

The **Community Room**, with Level Access, Kitchen Facilities and Toilet, is available for Hire for Meetings and Events, at very reasonable rates.
