Changes to services at Nidd Church

To guard against the spread of the Covid-19 virus, please

- Use the hand sanitiser on the table inside the door.
- Sign the contact book on the same table. These details will be kept for 21 days.
- Use face coverings.
- Sit in household groups and at least 1 metre from other people, noting that some pews are “out of bounds” to make this possible. Avoid “bunching” near the door.
- Avoid handshakes and hugs, however unnatural it seems.
- Books and service sheets can be used as they will rest for 7 days afterwards.
- No collection will be taken during the service. Instead, please leave your offering on the wooden plate as you leave.
- Communion – please remain seated in your pew and the priest will bring the consecrated bread to you.
- For the moment please don't sing and speak carefully to avoid spray. Humming is fine.
- Services will last no longer than 45 minutes.

Please contact either of the present wardens if you would like to explore the possibility.

At the time of writing, the series of Tuesday afternoon carol services running up to Christmas has not been finalised. Theoretically they will be held 10 November – 22 December, but it depends on whether the churches are still open and if singing is allowed. The same applies to Carols by Candlelight planned for 20 December.

We are still considering an alternative to one of the Mattins services. If you have any ideas please let us know.
