Did you know that October 10th is national handbag day? That the 25th is Mother in Law day, and the 24th Cat Day? No, neither did I, and other than talk-like-a-pirate day (aaaargh, that be Sept 19th) I'm not much impressed by any of the recent additions to the calendar.

I do, however, have a fondness for the keeping of saints days (I love a good feast), and the chance to reflect on those ordinary people who discovered something extraordinary as their gift to others.

Take Francis, for example, whose feast day is 4th October. Maybe you know him from the words attributed to him that form the basis of the song, Make me a channel of your peace. Or perhaps, you recall that he organised the first Christmas crib scene with live animals in 1223 - now that's an 800th anniversary we should keep in 2023. But I like Francis because he did what he believed was right.

His dad was a wealthy cloth merchant but Francis believed in living simply and bothered little about what he wore. He found an abandoned church and lived there, praying and helping others. When his dad worked out that Francis might inherit a good chunk of the family estate, Pietro took him to court to explain how irresponsible Francis was.

Francis simply agreed, renounced any inheritance, took off his clothes and walked away. This simplicity became a hallmark of his life and the community he founded with Clare, his sister.

Francis never owned a complete bible, never became a priest, never had a prayer book. He just got on with being Christ-like (Christian) in they way he felt called to be. Naturally, those who have written about him differ in their understanding, and there are those who love the gentle saint who preached to birds, converted wolves and padded around in flower-filled meadows.

For me, Francis highlights a paradox at the heart of the church because of his commitment to radical simplicity - a way of life that Franciscan sisters and brothers live out today. He wished for them to have nothing for themselves - and yet a stunning basilica was built at Assisi. It seems inevitable that our church institutions will take that simple message of love and peace, and quietly smother it in regulations, entombing it as well-intentioned but impractical,

In the midst of the pandemic, it's easy to lose track of the simplicity of the Christian message that speaks of love and compassion, hope and courage, joy and peace. It's easy to point the finger, lay the blame, excuse ourselves, and act out our fears.

In the coming months, the Christian calendar helps us confront the realities of life, and to find comfort in the truths that bind us together. The rituals around All Saints and All Souls; the recollections of Remembrance Day; the endarkened waiting of Advent; the joyous light and piercing truth of God-with-us at Christmas.

I hope in these dark months, you will be part of marking the days, keeping the hours. Perhaps you can notice and attend to how you might be, like Francis, most loving, most peace-giving, most generous, most forgiving. But please don't just strip off all your clothes, and go to live in an abandoned church. I wouldn't want to explain that to the bishop, Mark

The Food Bank always need: Tinned meat (stews, casseroles, ham), Tinned vegetables, Smash, UHT/Dried Milk, Sugar, Tinned fruit, Rice pudding, Custard, Coffee, Toothpaste, Soap & Toilet rolls.

We're working out how to adapt the annual All Soul's Service to meet Government restrictions. Watch out for news of this event, and details of how we will observe Remembrance Sunday (8th) and Remembrance Day, too.

December - Advent and Christmas will be marked very differently this year. Perhaps a life-sized nativity to visit; a Christmas story trail through the village; wrapped bales decorated with Christmas characters... get your thinking hats on and share your ideas with your church warden.

"In this most unusual year, we have just passed the autumnal equinox, the day which marks a turning point in the year with the days gradually beginning to shorten and the evenings drawing in.

From mid September to the end of October we can enjoy the richness of autumn, its beauty, its colours and its fruits. A special time and especially when the sun shines and we can get out in the garden or for walks shuffling through the leaves, collecting conkers and then home to enjoy tea and crumpets and a warm by the fire.

I like this piece from Katherine Swift's book 'the Morville Hours' about the onset of autumn:

'The wound-up watch-spring of summer is winding down. The days fill with rounded golden light, like a rich old Sauternes, full and sweet. Sugars caramelise in the leaves - tones of butterscotch, cinder toffee, treacle tart, quince paste, marmalade, toffee apple, Beaujolais, cassis. The hedgerow shines with great plates and bunches of glossy berries like so many jars of jelly and jam ranged on a larder shelf - scarlet hip and crimson haw; red bullace and yellow crab; purple elderberry and blue- black sloe. Trees blaze as if a reverse photosynthesis were taking place, green chlorophyll turning back into pure energy.'

Once we get through October we reach the Church's time of Remembrance. The first of November we celebrate All Saints Day and the second is All Souls Day known as the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed which celebrates the saints in a more local and intimate key, allowing us to remember with thanksgiving before God those whom we have known more directly: those who gave us life, or who nurtured us in faith.

Remembrance Sunday, on 8th November this year, goes on to explore the theme of memory, both corporate and individual, as we confront issues of war and peace and every year the nation unites to make sure that no-one is forgotten and to remember and honour those who have sacrificed themselves to secure and protect our freedom.

In this year of pandemic these commemorations will be particularly poignant and we pray for God's loving hand and to lead and guide us through this storm to stiller pastures."

You are all welcome to join us any week for **Wednesday (a) Ten** at St Michael's Ewyas Harold.

Sometimes, we use the Northumbria Community Morning Prayer service and at other times Common Worship. There is a short meditation, and John Hook plays the organ for us.


THOSE WHOM WE LOVE

(ERNEST) RONALD MORGAN - died 21 September 1944

I was contacted last month by Adri Los, a young man in the Netherlands who is voluntarily helping to look after the graves in the Valkenswaard military cemetery. Adri wrote to ask for information about (Ernest) Ronald Morgan and thus began the hunt. Fortunately, Ruth Truelove (a fountain of local knowledge) and Ruth Wrigglesworth (a great get-things-done person) came the rescue with a photo and tales of Morgan's Garage in Pontrilas Road from Joyce who was married to Wilf.

Ron was a corporal in the 4th Battalion Royal Welch (sic) Fusiliers and, in one of those great co-incidences, was buried just a few rows away from a relative of mine - also a corporal in the same regiment and killed just a few days after him.

It's a comfort to know that youngsters in the Netherlands are, to this day, honouring the young men and women who gave their lives for freedom and peace.

AROUND THE PARISHES

Walterstone Scripture Cake

from Rachel Whilding, Churchwarden

Ingredients

- 1. 225g (1/2 lb.) Judges 5, 25 (last clause)
- 2. 225g (1/2 lb.) Jeremiah 6, 20
- 3. 15ml (1 tbsp) | Samuel 14, 25
- 4. 3 of Jeremiah 17, II
- 5. 225g (1/2 lb.) I Samuel 30, 12
- 6. 225g (1/2 lb.) Nahum 3, 12 (chopped)
- 7. 50g (2 oz) Numbers 17, 8 (blanched and chopped)
- 8. 450g (1 lb.) I Kings 4, 22
- Season to taste with I Chronicles 9, 9

- 10. a pinch of Leviticus 2, 13
- 11. 5ml (1 tsp) Amos 4, 5
- 12. 45ml (3 tbsp) Judges 4, 19

Method

- Beat 1, 2, and 3 to a cream;
- add 4, one at a time, still beating;
- then add 5, 6, and 7, and beat again.
- Add 8, 9, 10 & 11 having previously mixed them, and then, lastly, 12.
- Bake in a slow oven (325F 160C) for 1 ½ hours. Test, as the timing will vary.
- Allow to cool for 30 minutes before turning out onto rack.






