Prayer of Preparation before the service

**Lord of the earth and everything in it ,
creator of the land and sea:
cleanse our hands and purify our hearts ,
that we may stand in your presence and worship you:
may we seek your face and receive your blessing :
for you are the Lord almighty, the King of glory -
and we open the doors of our hearts as you come among us.
Amen**

Welcome and Introduction

The service leader introduces the service.

O give thanks to the Lord and call upon his name:

make known his deeds among the people.

Sing to Him, sing praises to Him:

tell of all his wonderful works .

There may be a short period of silence and a prayer

**Oh Lord, whose mercy reaches to the heavens,
whose faithfulness knows no end:
let the greatness of your love be known to us,
that we may worship you with wonder, joy and thanksgiving
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen**

The Collect for the day

Confession

**Almighty God, our Heavenly Father,
we have sinned against you,
through our own fault ,
in thought, and word, and deed,
and in what we have left undone.
We are heartily sorry,
and repent of all our sins.
For your Son our Lord Jesus Christ's sake,
forgive us all that is past;
and grant that we may serve you in newness of life
to the glory of your name. Amen**

Absolution

The service leader says a prayer confirming that God forgives when we confess our faults.

Talk

Time to reflect and respond to God

Creed (when used)

**Christ died for our sins
in accordance with the Scriptures;
he was buried;
he was raised to life on the third day
in accordance with the Scriptures;
afterwards he appeared to his followers,
and to all the apostles:
this we have received,
and this we believe. Amen.**

(cf 1 Corinthians 15.3-7)

Spiritual Communion shared prayer (when used):

**Thanks be to you, Lord Jesus Christ,
for all the benefits you have given me,
for all the pains and insults you have borne for me.
Since I cannot now receive you in the bread and wine,
I ask you to come spiritually into my heart.
O most merciful redeemer, friend and brother,
may I know you more clearly,
love you more dearly,
and follow you more nearly, day by day. Amen.**
