

Churchwardens Report

2020

- 31 October** Official Gift Day took place - invitations sent/delivered and donations received on-line or sent to me by cheque - an amazing £1,375 received
- 3 November** Keith and Jackie sworn in as Churchwardens at Zoom Archdeacon's Visitation
- 18 December** Replacement cast iron drain pipe purchased for east end of church
- 25 December** We were delighted to be able to hold a Christmas Day service in church

2021

- 3 January** Digital Hymnal returned to manufacturer as faulty and replacement received within 2 days
- 9 January** Church voluntarily closed due to lockdown as agreed by PCC
- 19 January** Dawsons Steeplejacks came to install new drain pipe - failed as they stated would be best to have some "bends" - these have now been ordered
- 26 January** Dart Fire carried out annual inspection of Church fire appliances
Replaced two appliances
- 19 February** Trees and hanging brambles etc. were cut down by South Hams District Council along the wall to the South of the Church
- 23 February** A telephone Church Insurance Inspection took place with Ecclesiastical
- 11 March** Asbestos Management Survey carried out - all satisfactory
- 23 - 26 March** 5 year electrical testing carried out in church together with annual
7 April portable appliances testing and repair to tower lighting and other repairs.
At the same time it was discovered that the Western Power cable bringing electricity into the church had burnt out. This was then replaced immediately by WP
- 3 April** Church re-opened and our first service was on Easter Eve for Holy Communion at 6pm
- 19 April** Our electricity supplier SSE installed a smart meter in church so no more estimated readings
