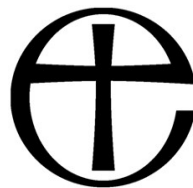

Fun, friendly and totally informal.

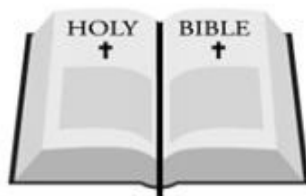
