From Your Parish Priest:

The days of sailors being tricked by the press gang into taking the "Queen's shilling" and thus pressed into naval service, are thankfully long gone, but there are still many areas of public life where people serve under, and with, the sovereign's authority. In our constitutional monarchy, those who protect our country, and those who make our laws and enforce them, all do so in the Queen's name, having formally declared their allegiance to her. These principles are enshrined in the processes of state, regardless of the human being sitting on the throne and wearing the crown. However, our hope and prayers are that our sovereign's reign will be characterised by faith in God and a life of service, setting an example to all in our nations.

In the traditional prayer for the sovereign, from the Book of Common Prayer dating back to the first Elizabethan era, we pray that the Queen:

"knowing whose minister she is, may above all things seek thy honour and glory, and that we and all her subjects, (duly considering whose authority she hath), may faithfully serve, honour, and obey her"

When she addressed the nation on her 21st birthday, the then Princess Elizabeth reflected this sense of partnership between monarchy and people, pledging her life to the service of God and country, but also asking our support and prayers for her in that endeavour. That commitment was of course restated and renewed at her coronation, and has been the principle by which she has lived and served in the ensuing 70 years of her reign.

As we prepare to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee, this extraordinary and unique milestone in our nation's history, we give thanks for her commitment and example. In doing so, we should perhaps also reflect on the extent to which we have lived up to our side of the partnership, and to the Christian values that she has demonstrated and exemplified. Included in the coronation service, was the prayer of thanksgiving:

Lord of our lives and Father of all, let our thanksgiving prove itself in service to you and to our Queen, our country and one another, for your Name's sake. Amen.

Amidst the street parties and other festivities, that prayer remains as relevant now as it was then, and should, I suggest, be part of our on-going commitment as we celebrate the Jubilee.

Benefice of St Benedict – Whilst the various legally-enforced COVID restrictions have all now lapsed, church and public health authorities continue to recommend a range of COVID precautions, particularly for larger indoor social gatherings or when local infections rates remain high, as is currently the case in North Norfolk. Accordingly, we encourage our congregations to maintain hand cleansing when entering/leaving church and to respect and care for those who feel they need to maintain social distancing. Holy Communion in one kind (ie just bread) will be available to all, but we would hope to re-instate the distribution of the wine at Communion in the near future, when infections rates have reduced sufficiently.

Letter from a treasurer (St. Benedict's Church)





For many years the Church Staithe has been a popular destination for local residents and visitors, offering a beautiful and tranquil location as a walk destination, mooring a boat or visiting the church. It is like an island at the end of a path, with the island owned by the Church and the responsibility of the Church.

In recent years, increasingly in need of some tender loving care, while working in the adjacent dyke, Amis have kindly and for no charge, carried out some remedial safety work on the Staithe, as the photos above. It has become apparent a substantial amount of money will need to be spent, with estimates in the order of £35,000 that would ensure the future of the Staithe for the next 30 years and beyond.

Plans are now being put together on how this money can be raised, with one idea being users of the Staithe (boats) are asked for a contribution. All suggestions on where this money could be raised would be gratefully received.

In the Church accounts, I have set up a "restricted fund" where money received for the staithe will be kept separately and only used for the Staithe. This now stands at £3,000 so we have a start.

Thank you to all those who donate to the Church and should you wish to help in some way or make a donation, including for the Staithe, please contact myself or anyone connected with St. Benedict's Church.
