

From the Curate

I have lived to the rhythms of the academic year since my youngest child started primary school 11 years ago and so September always makes me think of new beginnings. I have had many new beginnings in September over the years:

Four years ago I was just about to start at theological college in Oxford. I had



moved from Manningtree, my children had started their new schools and I was getting ready to start my new school – vicar school as some called it (much to the disgruntlement of the principal). Two years ago we had just moved to Debenham, my children had started their new schools and I had just started my curacy here in the benefice, more learning for me. This September my oldest child starts High school.

I have been spending one day a week at Debenham High School as chaplain to the school and it was my pleasure to be there on the day that the new intake came in for their induction day. There were some confident faces, some nervous laughter and yes, of course, some tears (from parents and children!) because starting something new—whilst exciting and much planned, can also be scary.

For me, I know that God goes with me into new situations. That although I might be nervous, worried or tearful, the one who loves me best is there and I know that I can rely on God's love and support. For Jesus also experienced new beginnings – the beginning of his ministry when he was baptised and when he called the disciples to follow him. The beginning of his fame as he taught and healed people. The beginning of tensions with the religious leaders and the Roman occupiers. The beginning of the end as Jesus was arrested. God knows all about scary situations and understands our fear, after all Jesus experienced these emotions too.

For those of you with a new beginning this September – for yourself, for someone in your family or your friends - I pray that it will be exciting and full of joy and at the same time that you would know God's peace in those anxious times.

For the first time in 10 years a wedding was held at St Catherine on the 18th of June. The marriage took place between Toby Rogers of Boundary Farm and Samantha Jones. The church was simply, but beautifully decorated with large milk churns filled with a variety of pale blue and pink flowers together with large white delphiniums. The guests arrived in a very novel way in a tractor drawn covered trailer. This overcame the problem of the small car park. The other lovely connection with this family and our church was that Toby's Great, Grandfather, Walter Henry Corner a Churchwarden, who died in 1987, had spent many hours making and carving many of the furnishings inside the church. It was a privilege that his family chose the church he had so loved for the wedding. We wish this lovely couple every happiness in their future years.

It is with great sadness that we have to announce the death of one of our oldest residents. Tony Thornton died peacefully in Ipswich Hospital on 21st July at the grand age of 98. Tony bought "The Bull" in Pettaugh with his wife Ena in 1978. He had retired as Chief Superintendent from the Metropolitan Police. He worked endlessly for years on the former pub to make it into a wonderful family home. Sadly, Ena died in 2011. Some of us were fortunate to have listened to the wonderful tales of Tony's early life in the Merchant Navy from the age of 14. He had travelled the world several times and had learnt many skills from his fellow crew members. He recounted details of the near misses he had encountered during the second World War. Each November he would come to the Remembrance Service wearing all his well deserved medals. In his latter years in Pettaugh he had been a Parish Councillor and served on the Parochial Church Council for many years. He was committed to our church and using one of his many talents he has carved some beautiful objects which can be seen in the church. He will be very much missed by his friends and all those in the village that knew him for so many years. Our heartfelt thoughts go out to all of his family.


