Post-COVID-19 Health and Safety announcement - SIP OR DIP!

The Parochial Church Council is pleased to announce that from Sunday 5 March those receiving the bread (wafer) and wine of Communion will be invited to do so in one of two ways. We're calling it 'Sip OR Dip'! Basically, if you want to keep on dipping the wafer in the wine, you can. If you want to eat the wafer then sip from the chalice instead, you can do that instead. The choice is yours, and - whatever we decide - may Jesus meet us all in the breaking of bread and outpouring of wine. Gluten free wafers are also available.

Findings of recent church building inspection - £1550 total cost

Every five years an architect inspects our church and issues a report (click here) for a summary of the 2022 report). At present we cannot afford the majority of these repairs (£1550) which means in five years' time the damage will have worsened and be more expensive. We appeal to you to help us afford these repairs so we can keep the building in good repair, safe and comfortable for all (i.e. open). Then there's the £30,000 Parish Share, utility bills and costs of ministry. One-off donations towards specific costs would be most welcome.
