	Outdoor displays	Appropriate outdoor displays at different times.	Redecorated and updated permanent notice board. Current (or possibly a replacement) changeable board kept up to date.
	Online communication	Keep ACNY and website (?) up to date.	Information about forthcoming events and services available on ACNY (at least) a month or more in advance

Youth mission	Draw up a detailed plan for clarifying what we can offer (beyond the current JC provision)	Planning of our own; how much can we manage within our own community and what can we realistically achieve? 	Establish what local people need	Within the limits of what we can provide, consult with families, school, Scouts etc.	An awareness of what local people would find useful

Social	Reinforce the current Social Committee	Continue the current range of social and community activities, supported by advertising and incorporation in the church's prayer life. Social activities promoted by the church to be seen as part of its mission rather than as 'extra' activities, and for this to be sensitively reflected in the activities themselves.	Successful activities; contacts through these activities leading to involvement in the worshipping life of the church
Serving	Service on a more individual level	Identify priorities of individual or family need	The community of the church seen as a place to find support, whether spiritual, emotional, practical or in terms of sound advice
Hall maintenance	Ensure that the hall remains fit for purpose	Establish a programme for repair and development, with the different tasks in the right order; decide how far we wish to go in refurbishment	A clear and costed plan for what we intend to do over a given time scale
