Emergency Police/Medical Attention:

If police presence or medical attention is required call 999

Non-Emergency:

For non-emergency situations call 101 (Police)

Medway Council Team (Stop Child Abuse)

No child should have to suffer abuse. The sooner you report it, the less a child will suffer. We're here to listen to you and talk through your worries with you.

However, small your concern, we offer support and advice – your information might help find the best outcome for the child.

Your call could save the life of a child. Don't leave it to chance. Call us immediately – don't assume someone else will.

What we need to know from you

The more information you can give us about what is happening the better. All calls will be strictly confidential and unless you give us permission, we will not tell anyone you called.

Adult and domestic abuse

No one should have to suffer abuse. Everyone has a right to be treated with respect and dignity and the earlier you report abuse, the less harm someone will suffer.

Medway Council's adult social care team will support you with any concerns you might have about abuse or neglect in adults.

What is abuse?

Abuse is when someone is caused harm by an individual or a group and can be physical, financial, sexual or emotional. It can happen anywhere – at home, in a nursing home, hospital or in public.
