## Preparing our Hearts for Christ's Arrival

As we enter the season of Advent, we are reminded of the profound significance it holds in the Christian faith. Advent, which means "coming" or "arrival," is a time of joyful anticipation and spiritual preparation for the celebration of the birth of Jesus Christ. It is a period of reflection, expectation, and hope as we await the coming of the Saviour, not only in the manger but also in our hearts.

Advent, which typically begins on the fourth Sunday before Christmas, is a time to prepare our hearts and minds for the celebration of Christ's birth.
