
THE MOST HOLY ROSARY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY DOMINICAN RITE



The Dominicans follow the medieval custom of beginning the Rosary like the Office of the Blessed Virgin Mary—for the Rosary is known as Mary's prayer.

The Most Holy Rosary of the BVM.

- 1. ★ Make the Sign of the Cross.
- 2. Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.
- 3. ★ O Lord, open my lips and my mouth shall proclaim your praise.

O God, make speed to save us. **O Lord, make haste to help us.**

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; As it was in the beginning is now, and shall be for ever. Amen.

4. Alleluia. (Lent: Praise be to you, O Lord, King of eternal glory.)

The leader announces the title of each Mystery (and may give a short meditation), and starts the prayers for the first, third and fifth mysteries. The congregation responds to conclude the prayers. After the leader announces the titles of the second and fourth Mysteries, the congregation leads, and the leader responds.

We offer this Rosary for the (intentions of ...)

- 5. Announce the First Mystery; then say the "Our Father."
- 6. Say ten "Hail Marys," while meditating on the Mystery.
- 7. Say the "Glory to the Father."
- **8.** Announce the Second Mystery; then say the "Our Father." Repeat 6 and 7 and continue with Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.

PRAYERS OF THE MOST HOLY ROSARY

First Decade: The Annunciation of Gabriel to Mary (Lk 1:26-38) **Second Decade:** The Visitation of Mary to Elizabeth (Lk 1:39-56)

Third Decade: The Nativity of Jesus (Lk 2:1-21) **Fourth Decade:** The Presentation of Jesus (Lk 2:22-38) **Fifth Decade:** The Finding of Jesus in the Temple (Lk 2:41-52)

On Thursday, meditate on the "Luminous Mysteries"

First Decade: The Baptism of Jesus (Mt 3:13-16) **Second Decade:** The Wedding at Cana (Jn 2:1-11)

Third Decade: Proclamation of the Kingdom of God (Mk 1:14-15)

Fourth Decade: The Transfiguration of Jesus (Mt 17:1-8)

Fifth Decade: The Eucharist (Mt 26: 1-35)

On Tuesday & Friday, (and Sundays in Lent) meditate on the "Sorrowful Mysteries"

First Decade: The Agony in the Garden (Mt 26:36-56) **Second Decade:** The Scourging at the Pillar (Mt 27:26) **Third Decade:** The Crowning with Thorns (Mt 27:27-31)

Fourth Decade: Carrying the Cross (Mt 27:32) **Fifth Decade:** The Crucifixion (Mt 27:33-56)

On Wednesday and Sundays, meditate on the "Glorious Mysteries"

First Decade: The Glorious Resurrection (Jn 20:1-29)

Second Decade: The Ascension (Lk 24:36-53)

Third Decade: The Descent of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-41) **Fourth Decade:** The Assumption of Mary into Heaven

Fifth Decade: Coronation of Mary as Queen of Heaven & Earth.
