SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

If you are interested in your child attending Lindley Church of England Infant School, one of the criteria is to be "at the heart of the church". This means attending St Stephen's regularly (at least once per month) for at least 12 months before applying for a place at the school. This is especially pertinent when places are oversubscribed.

A register of attendance is kept at all Junior Church sessions. When you attend any other worship you must add your details to the church school families register to note your attendance.

OUR REGULAR OFFER

Join our vibrant gathering of young people and families. We learn about living in God's world through stories, craft, games, songs and community activities. A typical month in school term-time includes:

- 3rd Sunday each month at 4pm

ABOUT JUNIOR CHURCH AND FIGS

Junior Church (up to age 7) & FIGS (age 7+) meet at 10.30am in a separate space to the main Sunday worship. Sessions are run by voluntary leaders and helpers who are safely recruited through church.

Adults are encouraged to join in with the main worship on the balcony or downstairs. The groups join the service to receive a blessing at the end of communion and for refreshments after the service.
