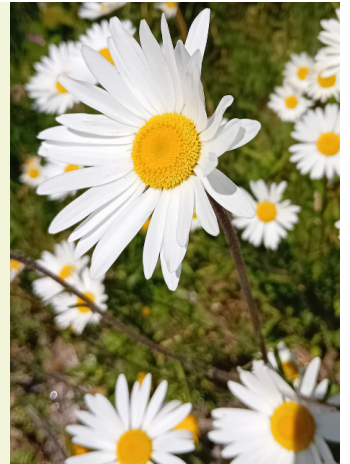

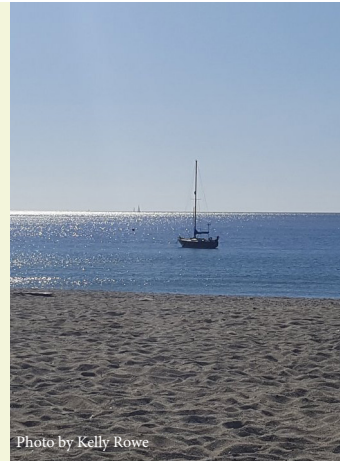

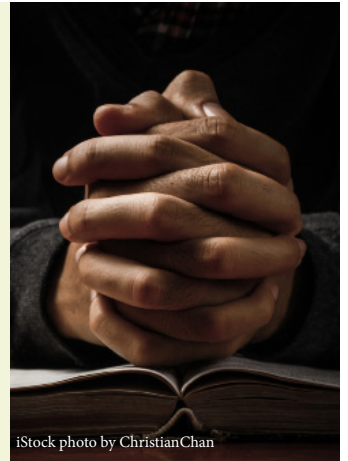
SUNDAY 20 JULY THOSE IN NEED

Lord of peace,

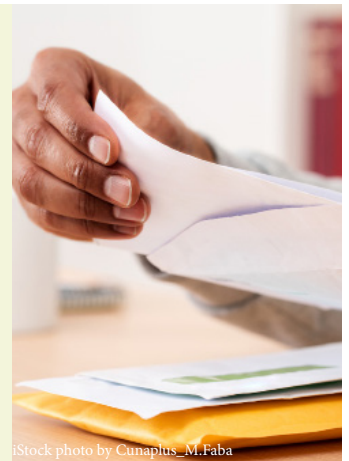

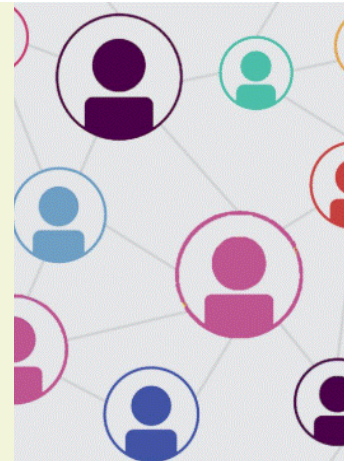
