Focus on: MAF (Mission Aviation Fellowship), with Ben and Esther, Barny, Reuben and Jesse Brown, in Arnhem Land, Northern Australia

- Pray for Ben, Esther and the family as Ben leads the team in Arnhem Land and pray that many lives will be transformed by the love of Christ.
- Pray for the communities in Arnhem Land cut off by floods in the spring, as they seek to repair damage. Praise God for the MAF flights which provided much needed provisions
- Pray for the growth of the UK volunteer team so that interest and awareness of MAF's work is spread in more churches and groups.

13-19 July

Focus on: Open Doors

- A CMS-facilitated team of indigenous mission leaders are focusing on developing people who are already in positions of leadership and raising up new leaders to guide the next generation in their faith. Pray for new and potential leaders.
- In partnership with the Diocese of Northern Argentina, CMS is helping to support 13 indigenous women to study at the Anglican Formation Centre (CeFA) in Ingeniero Juárez to equip them to serve the church. As a result of recent flooding, some CeFA students were unable to return to their communities for their two-week study break. Please pray for them to be able to return home soon, and for those rebuilding their homes and communities
- Pray for former mission partner Nick Drayson as he fulfils his new role as a trustee for CMS.

10-16 August

Focus on: Winchester City Centre Chaplaincy

- Pray for the new Listening Service, meeting twice a month at St Lawrence's Church, where adults can come and talk to an experienced listener in a free and safe place, and the new monthly Christian mindfulness meditations 'Take Time Together' which started in June.
- Pray for others to join the team. More retail chaplains are needed, another person to join the team in the courts and the establishment of a team to go back into the City Council. Uphold Alison Dolphin, lead chaplain, as she coordinates training of new volunteers.
