

#### **ECKINGTON WI**



For last months meeting we were fortunate to have our very own member Rosemary Forson give a talk on Adire (a textile that is the indigo-dyed cloth made in south western Nigeria by Yoruba women, using a variety of resist-dyeing techniques) and other Nigerian fabrics that Rosemary came across while working out in Nigeria. Men traditionally wove cloth on horizontal looms 10cm wide which was then sewn together to make garments. Women wove Adire Eleco is cloth on vertical looms. decorated with designs using a cassava paste (a versatile food product made from the cassava root, which is processed into a paste or dough-like consistency) and a feather. All cloths are given a name, for example 'sweet life'. Rosemary brought along many beautiful examples of cloths and clothing for us to handle and appreciate the hours of work that was involved in the preparation before dying, for example stenciling with a feather or tying. Both Rosemary and her husband were wearing very attractive traditional Nigerian outfits. This was a very interesting talk and slide show and gave us a full understanding the amount of work that is required to produce this beautiful bold and colourful fabric and the creativity of the designs.

Our 'Social at the local' was held at the Bell and as usual we had a lovely time chatting whilst drinking our delicious coffee.

Our next 'Social at the Local' will be on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> August at 2.30 pm at the
