# The Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

## Parish Mass 9.30am

The readings for the 20<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time challenge us to think deeply about the cost of following Jesus. Through the stories of Jeremiah and the words of Jesus, we see the difficulties that come with living out our faith. Despite often experiencing hard times in life, we are called to stay faithful, to receive the transforming fire of God's love for us, and to meet the challenges in life, face on. Following Jesus was never going to be the easy way out. Discipleship can lead to challenges, even rejection from those closest to us. Being a Christian means that we may sometimes feel out of place in the world of today. Our beliefs and values might clash and even lead to conflict. Jesus reminds us that these struggles are part of the journey of faith. We are called to be courageous in the face of these challenges. Jesus promises to be with us in these struggles.




BINGO CLUB takes place this Saturday after the BBQ. BBQ starts at 12noon and bingo at the usual time of 2pm. Everyone welcome!
