"Do not come any closer", God said. "Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground." Exodus 3:5



Helping Homeless People

Do you feel uncomfortable walking past people who are homeless? Maybe you feel you should do your bit to help them, but you are not sure how to do it?

One very practical way you could help them would be to donate to Lancaster and District Homeless Action Service (LDHAS). This is a charity that offers services to local homeless people and those in housing poverty. These include practical help such as breakfast and lunch, showers and laundry facilities, clothing, medical support, access to phones and assistance with form filling. They also offer advice and information about claiming benefits, accessing housing, drug and alcohol treatment services and employment.

It costs the charity a lot to provide these services so they are always grateful for financial contributions. If you wish to make a donation you can do so through their just giving site https://www.justgiving.com/charity/ldhas

You can also leave donations of food and clothing in the boxes at the back of St Oswald's and St John's Churches.

They would be very grateful for donations of clothing suitable for 30 – 40-year-old men particularly jeans sizes 32 – 34", boxers, t-shirts, trainers and socks.

They would also be grateful for donations of food to help them provide breakfasts and lunch, particularly long life semi skimmed milk, tinned vegetables, cereals, coffee and sugar.





Bubble Church continues to flourish at St Oswald's! It is also flourishing across the country with 72 churches now offering these half hour services specifically for families with young children. They include puppets, interactive songs, prayers and activities. They are filled with fun, joy and excitement!





Our services are held on the second Sunday of each month at 11.30 am in St Oswald's Church Hall and they are followed by a free light lunch. Everyone is welcome! Those who attend love how friendly and inclusive they are and how accessible the services are for their children. While attending a regular church service can be quite stressful for parents, these are not and can be enjoyed by all the family!





We have a team of people who organise and run the services ranging in age from 9 to over 70 years. There are all sorts of roles – from welcoming, preparing refreshments through to puppeteering, leading and sorting the audiovisuals. Something for everyone! The team are very committed, full of enthusiasm and very welcoming, so, if you think you might be interested in joining them, why not come along to a service and see what it is all about?

Junior Church

Our Junior Church continues to thrive. We had a busy summer term first thinking about the events that happened to Jesus and his friends after Easter and then reflecting on how amazing God is! This included thinking about how God is three and one at the same time, he can do amazing things, he can change people in amazing ways and finally – during out annual visit to Hyning – we thought about how he turns the world upside down!

God tells us not to hurt those that hurt us, but to love them. So we prayed for someone who had hurt us and then decorated stones with hearts and made something beautiful out of them.





God tells us to serve one another. Through games we came to realise that serving is more than helping, it is about recognising other people's needs and trying to meet those needs.



God tells us to love everyone, equally. Using card figures we thought about how we often group or rank people and consider some to be "better" than others or we fail to notice those who who are not able to join in easily. These are not God's way. God asks us to value everyone, equally.







Finally, Sister Audrey summed up what we had learnt through a demonstration. She showed us how, when God's love pours on us, if we are the wrong way up, it all goes to waste. But if we are the right way up, God's love can fill us and overflow onto those around us. And suddenly we realised that we had got it wrong all along! God isn't asking us to turn the world upside down at all, he is asking us to turn it back the right way up – his way!





The autumn term starts with the Season of Creation. We will be thinking about something we often take for granted in God's creation – water! We will be consider how the ways we use water and the things we put into water might impact other people and nature, not only in this country but all over the world. We will be trying to work out the things we can do to make sure we treat this wonderful resource with the respect and consideration it deserves.

Do get in touch if you would like to know more about Junior Church. We meet in St Oswald's Church Hall from 11 - 12am with children aged 3 to 11 and under 3's accompanied by an adult. St John's Eco journey started in 2012 with a major development, including a disabled toilet, improved accessibility, Sunday school room and kitchen at back of the church. Solar panels were installed and in 2016 an Air source heat pump was added making the church one of the greenest in the country. With a green energy tariff our church is Carbon Neutral, in line with Church of England target of Net Zero carbon by 2030.






