Know that the Lord is God.

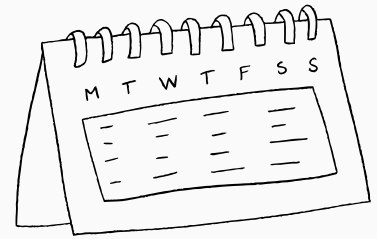
It is he who made us, and we are his;
