







WELCOME



God's Green Earth

Swarm Collecting

I am talking about swarms of honey bees! About this time of year, May to June, though sometimes earlier or later, a healthy strong hive of honey bees will have a natural inclination, nay urge, to swarm. This is the way honey bee colonies perpetuate themselves and increase their number. Beekeepers have various ingenious schemes to manage this increase which avoid swarms, but many swarms still emerge from hives despite their efforts.

Most readers will have seen pictures of swarms, even if they have not encountered one themselves. These are usually settled swarms, often hanging from the branch of a tree, and containing possibly tens of thousands of bees, mostly worker bees, but with some drones besides their solitary queen bee. But sometimes you may see the swarm on the move; quite a sight if they are close by, though you may see them flying in a cloud way overhead on the path to a possible new home.

There are a good number of beekeepers with hives in our area, so you may well come across a settled swarm. There is normally little danger from them if you keep your distance – there will always be some of them flying to and from the swarm as they look for a new home. Before they fly off there, beekeepers like to collect the swarm. Otherwise they may find a home somewhere they are NOT wanted, such as an unused chimney. Those capped with mushroom cowls are very attractive to them!

Your best action then is to search online for 'swarm collector'. Close to the top should come the British Beekeepers Association link to a map for finding your closest registered swarm collector – just put in your postcode. They are not on standby all the time, so you may have to try one or two. Around here you may find it helpful to extend the map to the Kendal area. It can be entertaining to watch a swarm collector at work, but as a former swarm collector I know that it can be demanding.

A swarm in the front wheel arch of a car was very challenging! It was more fun to go up to a chimney in a cherry picker, but that was to remove an established colony. We smoked out the bees and filled a large basket, including some delicious new honeycomb.

Junior Church Lent Challenge

Junior Church would like to say a huge thank you to everyone who supported our Lent Challenge this year. We were collecting donations for Eggcup, a local charity based in Lancaster that stops surplus food from going to waste and gets it to people who need it at a price they can afford.

Eggcup intercepts food that would otherwise go to waste from farms, factories, distribution centres, shops and other food businesses. The food is safely stored at their Community Food Hub and sorted by a team of volunteers. The food is then taken to three Community Food Outlets – one in Lancaster, one in the West End of Morecambe and one in Carnforth. There, Egg Cup members come and pay £5 for a carrier bag of mixed fruit and vegetables, some store cupboard items like pasta sauces, biscuits and beans and fresh items such as meat, cheese or ready meals. The scheme helps those with limited finances to be able to buy good quality food while also helping the planet by cutting down on food waste.

The charity does not normally allow visits, but they very kindly let us come and look around and told us more about their work. We saw the warehouse with its big freezers where the food is sorted and stored and the area where the members come to buy the food. We learned about all the different jobs the 100 volunteers carry out. We discussed the difference between use by dates and best before dates and found out that, at the moment, they are supporting 450 families each week across their three food outlets.

It was a fascinating visit and they made us feel very welcome, preparing a treasure hunt for us to do as we learnt more about their work.

With ever increasing demand and a reduction in the amount of available surplus food, the charity is very stretched and were extremely grateful for our donations.




