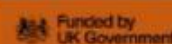

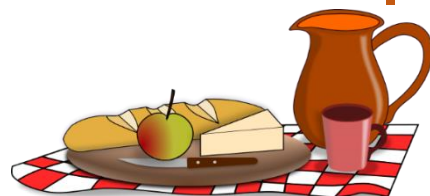
### Harvest Festival
