#### Dear Friends,

Recently a friend recommended an app to me. It's called Merlin, and when you have downloaded it onto your phone, you can use it to help you identify birds. Even when you can't see them, you can record their singing and the app suggests what species they might be. Then you can set up a 'life list' containing details of the species you've identified. I have always loved listening to the birds, but now I am beginning to learn some of their songs. There's plenty to listen to walking around the benefice, or sitting in the garden. On a recent visit to London there were a parakeet and a very noisy robin outside my bedroom window.

Sometimes I feel I'd like to have an app on my phone to help me understand what God is saying. Faced with a difficult decision, struggling with loss or ill-health, or just feeling we have missed our way a bit, it is not always easy to hear God's voice amongst the cacophony of our lives.

But Jesus promises to be with us always. He promises that if we take time to listen, we will hear his voice guiding, encouraging and challenging us. Sometimes we hear his voice as we read the Bible, as we pray, or as we talk to those we love and trust. It might be a whisper, or just an inward nudge. Sometimes it will be like the loud chatter of the robin, impossible to ignore.

Meeting with other Christians gives us the opportunity to talk about what we think we've heard from God, and what it might mean. The Alpha course is a good place to do that. We'll be running Alpha at Holy Trinity Minsterley in the autumn – watch out for details!
