

General Synod Vacancy

The General Synod is the national assembly of the Church of England. Synod considers and approves legislation affecting the whole of the Church of England, formulates new forms of worship, debates matters of national and international importance and approves the annual budget for the work of the Church at national level. It is made up of representatives from the bishops, clergy and lay people. It is a hugely important body and has made some crucial decisions in recent years, such as the ordination of women bishops.

A vacancy for a lay person from our diocese has just opened up!

All of us have both frustration and great love for the Church of England and perhaps some of you have wished to change and/ or conserve certain aspects of it. Becoming a General Synod Member would allow you to contribute to the debate and through your vote - to actual decision making. If that sounds like you please pray about whether this might be for you. If you want more information about the Synod and the process of being elected please contact Rev. Alex and he will pass on the information.
