Dear friends

I was driving towards Hanwood on Tuesday when I spotted a car coming the other way flashing its lights at me. Within a couple of hundred yards, half a dozen other cars had also flashed their lights as an evident warning. My first thought was that the police were on patrol looking for speeding motorists. My second thought was that this is Shropshire and on Sunday we had been focusing on the parable of the Lost Sheep, and we might well be having a live reenactment! But no, it proved to be an Officer of the Law with a speed gun, having a pretty fruitless time of it, I suspect. I found myself reflecting how this bond of camaraderie forms between motorists who don't otherwise know each other, as if we were playing out a latter-day version of Smokey and the Bandit. There are very few of us who haven't lamented the idiocy of someone driving too fast on our roads or mourned tragic accidents caused by dangerous driving. Why, therefore, do we seek to impede the police trying to do something about this?

I suspect that most of us have entered Hanwood driving at 35 mph and therefore reckon that this is an excusable sin, and that therefore our fellow drivers ought to be protected from the consequences of it, while really dangerous drivers are a different order from us. The Bible warns us against this. Judge not lest ye be judged (Matthew 7.1) and remove the log from your own eye before seeking to remove the speck of sawdust from your brother's eye (Luke 6.42)
