The Christmas Shoebox appeal



News from Chester Diocese



St Oswald's, St John's, and Holy Trinity Churches make up one benefice (a group of churches). We are part of the Church of England. Locally, we are part of Chester Diocese - an area stretching from Stockport to Liverpool, and Warrington to Malpas. The diocese is overseen by our Diocesan Bishop - Bishop Mark, and two suffragan Bishops - Bishop Julie and Bishop Sam. I'm often asked 'what do the diocese do?' and my answer is 'a lot!' From training clergy and lay readers, to offering free events, advice and support to churchwardens, treasurers and safeguarding officers, safeguarding checks, clergy appointments, managing buildings, managing CofE schools...and much, much more.
