People of Faith Naomi and Ruth

During one of the regular famines to hit the lands, Elimelek took his wife, Naomi and his sons Mahlon and Kilion from their home in Bethlehem to the land of Moab. Elimelek died and his sons married Moabite women Orpah and Ruth. After around ten years, Mahlon and Killon also died leaving Naomi with her two daughters in law. Naomi heard that the Lord had provided back in her home country and prepared to return to Bethlehem. She tried to persuade Orpah and Ruth to remain in Moab. Oprah stayed but Ruth declared **"Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people and your God my God."**

They arrived in Betlehem just as the barley harvest was beginning. Ruth went out to glean grain from a field owned by Boaz, a relative of Naomi. This was permitted as field owners were required to leave parts of their fields un-harvested to allow the poor, widows and foreigners to benefit, Boaz told his workers to be extra generous with Ruth and allow her to work with his teams. Eventually, Boaz took Ruth as his wife. They had a son named Obed who was the father of Jesse, the father of the future King David.
