The Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Harvest Festival Mass 9.30am

This Sunday we are reminded to notice God's blessings in our lives and are called to give thanks for what He has done. The readings show healing, mercy, and the gift of faith. They help us see that faith grows stronger when we trust God and give Him praise.

Naaman is healed after listening to the prophet Elisha. He chooses to follow the God of Israel. In the Gospel, ten lepers are healed, but only one comes back to thank Jesus. This man, a Samaritan, shows true faith by giving thanks.

These stories remind us that faith is not just believing. It is also saying thank you to God. This Sunday we are invited to reflect and consider whether we thank God enough for His care and love.
