

WELCOME

As I write this, the Anglican Church is celebrating the news of the appointment of The Rt Revd and Rt Hon Dame Sarah Mullally as the 106th Archbishop of Canterbury. + Sarah was my Diocesan Bishop whilst I was serving in London Diocese, and she also ordained me as Deacon at St Paul's Cathedral on September 26th 2020. I have met her on a number of occasions, and was privileged, shortly before my appointment to the United Benefice, to serve as deacon alongside her as she presided and preached at the Eucharist at St Mary's Abbots, Kensington.

I commend +Sarah to you as someone who offers a ministry which is wise, kind, and hopeful. She embodies courage, compassion and generosity. She has shown herself to be someone who in her current role as Bishop of London has been able to draw alongside others, celebrating diversity of theology and practice, and yet drawing brothers and sister in Christ together in fellowship and prayer. This is a true gift for our Anglican Communion as we seek to find our unity in Jesus Christ.

Sarah has spoken very powerfully about her calling and her hope for the Church in a 15 minute video which is available on the Archbishop of Canterbury's YouTube channel. I highly commend it to you. I particularly loved her speaking about her vocation – which hasn't changed despite different roles as a nurse, then in NHS leadership, then as a wife and mother, a priest and a Bishop. She said that her vocation has run through all of those roles, because her one vocation is to follow Jesus Christ.

I pray that as we celebrate the news of our new Archbishop Sarah, we too can take the opportunity to thank God for His calling on her life, and His calling on ours too. May you remember that, however you live out your calling, in whatever roles and responsibilities in or outside of the Church, your vocation too is to follow Jesus Christ, and to make Him known.







Helping Homeless People

Do you feel uncomfortable walking past people who are homeless? Maybe you feel you should do your bit to help them, but you are not sure how to do it?

One very practical way you could help them would be to donate to Lancaster and District Homeless Action Service (LDHAS). This is a charity that offers services to local homeless people and those in housing poverty. These include practical help such as breakfast and lunch, showers and laundry facilities, clothing, medical support, access to phones and assistance with form filling. They also offer advice and information about claiming benefits, accessing housing, drug and alcohol treatment services and employment.

It costs the charity a lot to provide these services so they are always grateful for financial contributions. If you wish to make a donation you can do so through their just giving site https://www.justgiving.com/charity/ldhas

You can also leave donations of food and clothing in the boxes at the back of St Oswald's and St John's Churches.

They would be very grateful for donations of clothing suitable for 30 – 40-year-old men particularly jeans sizes 32 – 34", boxers, t-shirts, trainers and socks.

They would also be grateful for donations of food to help them provide breakfasts and lunch, particularly long life semi skimmed milk, tinned vegetables, cereals, coffee and sugar.

Let's keep our seas plastic free!

That is the campaign we are organising in Junior Church. During the Season of Creation we have been thinking about God's gift of water and particularly about the damage that is being caused to his creation by the amount of plastics in our seas.



now thought to be 171 trillion pieces of plastic in our oceans!

This plastic is causing all sorts of problems. 10% of all dead animals found in beach clean ups were entangled in plastic. 90% of sea birds are thought to be eating plastic thinking it is food and 52% of sea turtles have swallowed plastic bags mistaking

them for jelly

fish. The plastics in the sea are making the water more acidic, making it harder for creatures to breath and grow

Did you know that every year 400 million tons of plastic is produced and half of that is designed to be used once and then thrown away? Given that plastics take 400 years to break down, and only

17% of the plastics produced are

recycled, it is no wonder that there are



And we are not immune from the problems either.

Microplastics have been found in human food including tap and bottled water and salt.

So, what should we be doing about this? We think there are three important ways to tackle the problem and we can all play our part.

Remove the plastic that has got into our oceans.

Are you doing your bit to prevent plastic from entering our rivers and seas? Do you pick up litter and take your rubbish home? Could you join in organised litter picks? Do you wash your recycling and make sure your recycling bin lids are well secured? Do you avoid flushing plastics of any kind down the toilet? Could you lobby manufacturers to use less plastic or sign up for the Big Plastic Count 2026 https://thebigplasticcount.com/

3. Use less plastic

Are there changes you could make so that you use less plastic? How about eating ice cream from a cone, changing to teabags that don't contain plastic or buying only plastic free chewing gum? How about giving homemade party treats instead of plastic ones, steering clear of glitter, or taking your own container to a takeaway? Could you ditch the cling film, use wooden chopping boards or snack on fruit instead of crisps and sweets?

We are sure that there are lots of things we can all do to help with the massive problem of plastics in our oceans and if we all do those things, we will be playing our part in looking after God's wonderful creation!






