## Appointment of Project Manager – St Mary's in the Marketplace, Stockport Phase 7

The Parochial Church Council ("PCC") for the Parish of Stockport & Brinnington is seeking to appoint a Project Manager to support the delivery of the **St Mary's in the Marketplace, Stockport Phase 7 (Heritage Centre) Project**, a National Lottery Heritage Fund supported heritage project involving conservation works to the church building, development of a sustainable heritage operating model to ensure organisational sustainability and promote access and inclusion to the heritage of the church. ### Scope of the role
