### Blessing our homes

As we are working our way through Epiphany, it is an old Church tradition, during this season, to bless our homes, churches, pet's homes, etc for the year ahead. This is traditionally done by chalking, with blessed chalk, the following above, on, or near the door: 20+C+M+B+26 & praying together:

"May Christ bless our home and remain with us throughout the new year. Christus mansionem benedicat, "May Christ bless the house."

The meaning of the inscription is as follows :

The numbers represent the year, the + represents Christ (Jesus) & the letters are for the Wise men who visited Jesus in his home. The names we associate the Wise Men with are Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. However, these are also the first letters of the latin phrase, meaning 'Christ bless this house', as above.

If you want to give this a try, please take some of the blessed chalk home with you, following the service, chalk your homes and pray the prayer.

2026 will be a special year for **Blackburn Diocese** as it celebrates its Centenary. Look out for news of upcoming events in the next few months.
